Learning By Doing

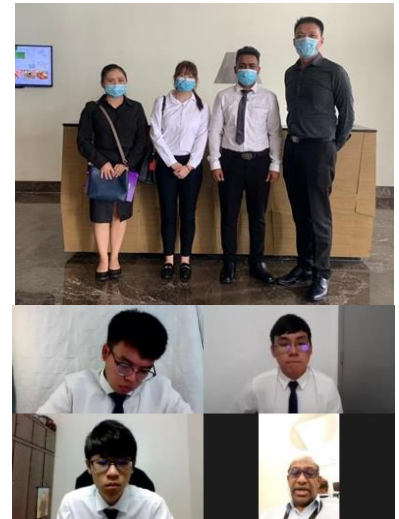

Virtual Education Campaign on Covid-19

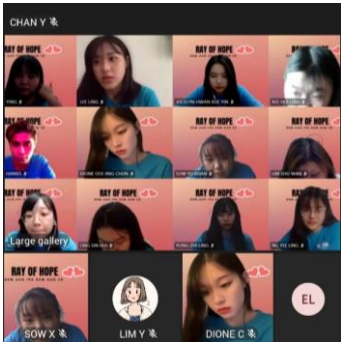

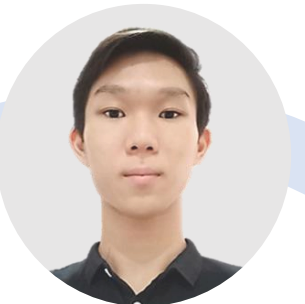

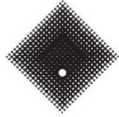
